


## Want a deeper look into what we've been doing?

#### Calls received: 3,899



Our 24/7 crisis lines have been called nearly 3,900 times in 2025 alone. When we highlight the importance of our crisis lines, we do so to let everyone know in the community know we're here for them.

#### Clients Engaged in Services: 1,138



It is no secret that Albion Fellows Bacon Center is more than just an emergency shelter for anyone in the community experiencing abuse, we offer numerous forms of mobile advocacy across the eleven counties we serve. In just six months, we've served 212 clients

through emergency shelter and **926** clients through mobile advocacy.

### **Victimization Types**



Albion Fellows Bacon Center offers support to many types of survivors across eleven counties in Southern Indiana. Of our clients specifically in shelter, we served survivors of the following victimizations.

**Domestic Violence: 100 Clients** 

**Sexual Violence: 25 Clients** 

**Stalking: 37 Clients** 

**Human Trafficking: 3 Clients**
